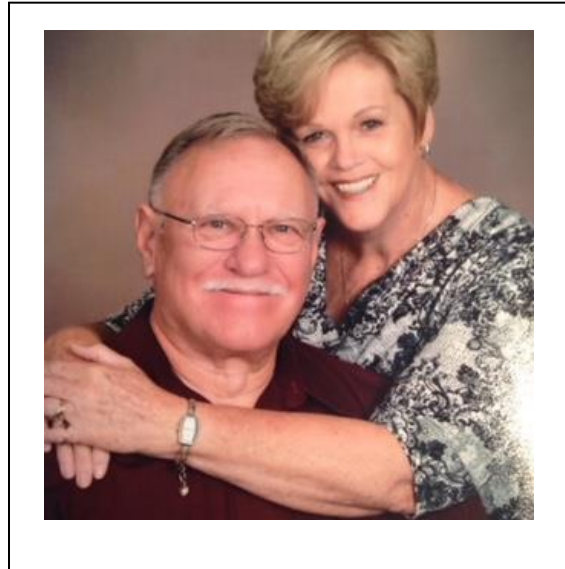


Luther “Ed” Boyett
